

Proper shower enclosure installation should include the application of silicone where and when appropriate.

This may include, but may not be limited to, the inside and outside of extrusions and glass that make contact to the shower base, rise, walls, and/or ceilings; at mitered or stacked metal or glass joints; inside extruded ends for bases on the threshold and bases on knee walls; and/or any holes or structural penetration; and glass to glass corners.

While liquid silicone may be required, it is not sold or provided by Quality Enclosures. Please refer to your preferred silicone manufacturer for proper application and use.
